



Mayor's Arts Council Scholarship Award 2017

The new Goshen Mayor's Arts Council Scholarship Award is being offered to full-time and part-time students currently

enrolled in an accredited degree program at any college or university in the United States, as well as to Advanced Placement high school students and post-graduate or non-traditional students.

This \$1,000 scholarship award is meant to inspire and further the arts in the civic environment. Applicants must have a strong connection to Goshen, Indiana, and also must be actively pursuing advanced education in either the visual or performing arts.

Priority for the award is based on both need and potential. Scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for the award:

- 1) Be a legal resident of the United States and/or hold a valid student visa
- 2) Align with the factors described in the first two paragraphs
- 3) Submit the application by August 31, 2017.

The scholarship winner will be determined solely by the Mayor's Arts Council of Goshen.

To apply for the Goshen Mayor's Arts Council Scholarship Award, submit the attached PDF application and an essay of 750 to 1,000 words. See bottom of application for details.
