

Since 2010, the City of Goshen has embraced the idea of permeable pavement and has incorporated permeable pavers into six publicly visible projects:

- ◆ The Millrace Dam Headgates Parking Lot (2010)
- The Millrace Powerhouse Outdoor Seating Area (2011)
- ◆ The NIPSCO Parking Lot (2012)
- Park Avenue Reconstruction (2013)
- Jefferson Street Reconstruction (2013)
- Madison Street Reconstruction by the Hawks Building (2015)
