

ORDINANCE 4613

AMENDING THE APPLICATION OF RESIDENTIAL SUMMER SEWER

WHEREAS the sewer bills currently issued in the months June through September are based on the lower of the actual volume of sewage discharged for the particular month, or the average volume of sewage discharged for the sewer bills issued in the immediately preceding months of November through April;

WHEREAS sewer bills are issued from two to six weeks after the actual meter reading, therefore, a residential customer may incur a significantly higher sewer bill in October due to increased outdoor watering occurring in August and/or September;

WHEREAS City administration wishes to expand the months in which residential summer sewer will apply to sewer bills.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Goshen that:

SECTION 1. Amendment. Goshen City Code Title 5, Article 3, Chapter 18, Section 4, subsection (b) shall be amended to add the sewer bill issued in the month of October to the application of residential summer sewer.

SECTION 2. Severability. The invalidity of any portion of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of the ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, adoption and publication as required by law.
