

Question & Answer

1. **When will the construction start?** Construction on Kercher from the railroad tracks to Weymouth will start on April 9th. Kercher will be closed and traffic will be detoured onto SR 15, Waterford Mills Parkway, and to Dierdorff. Weymouth and Kercher will remain open.
2. **How will I be able to get to my house and where can I park my vehicle?** Access to your driveway will be provided during construction. The contractor will coordinate with each residence if access will need to be temporarily closed, especially when construction is occurring immediately in front of the residence.
3. **How will the garbage truck get to my house?** Trash pickup should not be impacted by this work. In the event trash pickup is impacted, residents will be notified and pickup will be arranged.
4. **How will I get my mail?** Temporary mailboxes will be located on the northeast corner of Weymouth Blvd & Colorado St. This switch will occur on April 9th. Existing mailboxes will be removed and put near the residence's garage to avoid damage.
5. **Can I remove the stakes and flags from my yard?** The stakes and flags are used for the construction of the project. Please do not remove the construction stakes or flags.

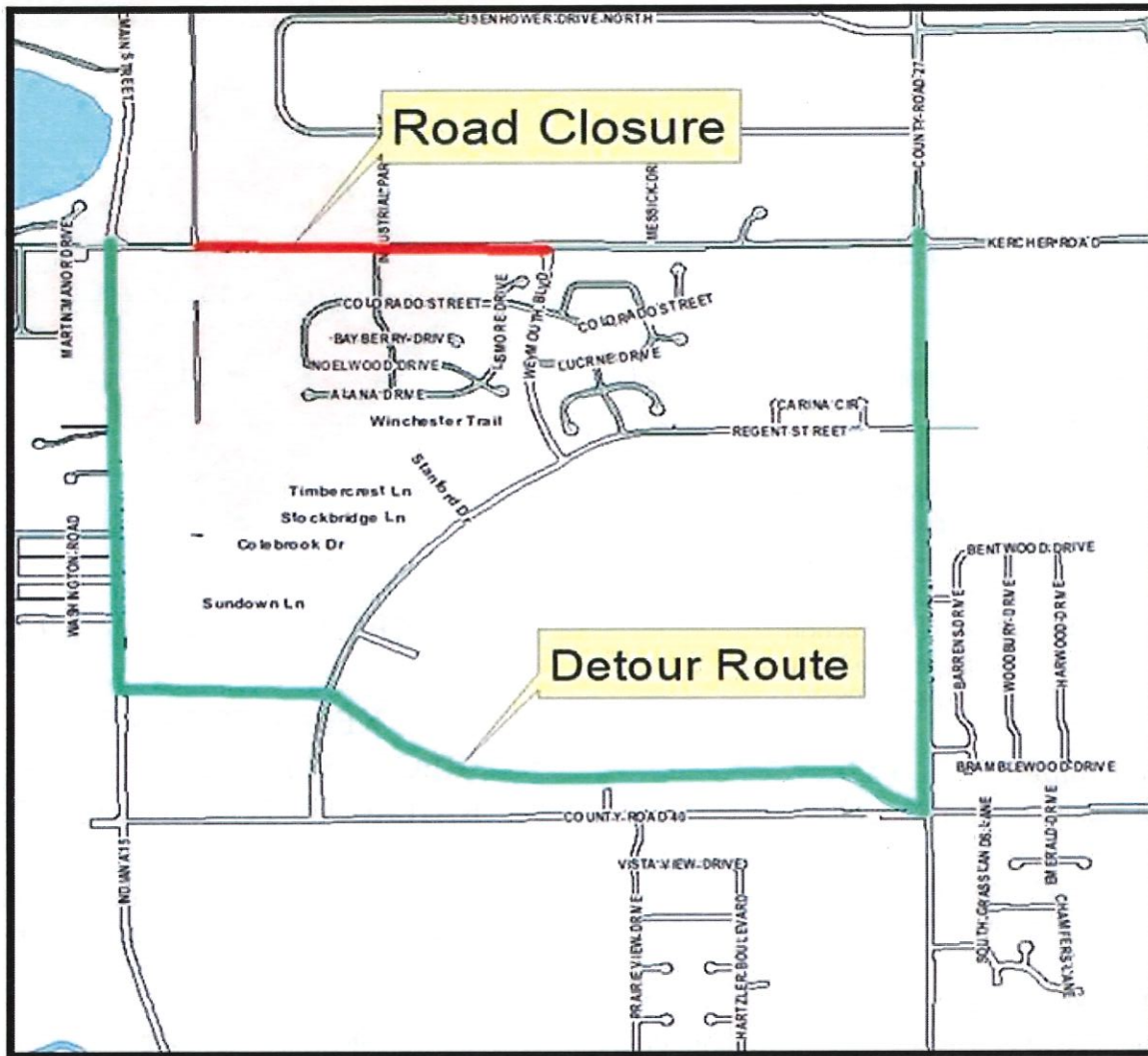

KERCHER ROAD RECONSTRUCTION FROM RAILROAD TO WEYMOUTH BLVD



What To Expect

On Monday, April 9th, Rieth-Riley Construction will close Kercher Road between the railroad tracks and Weymouth Blvd. Weymouth Blvd and Kercher Road will remain open during this phase.

Several of the utility companies have already begun relocating their facilities for the construction of the new roadway.

Project Description

Reconstruction and widening of Kercher Road to Weymouth Blvd from the Norfolk Southern Marion Branch railroad tracks. This project will continue where the county left off by reconstructing Kercher Road and adding a two way left turn lane and a 10' bike path on the south side. Eventually Kercher Road will be completely rebuilt all the way from County Road 17 to U.S. 33.
