Bidders shall complete all information and submit their offer on forms supplied by the City. Bidding information, instructions and forms can be obtained from the Clerk-Treasurer's Office, 202 South 5th Street, Goshen, Indiana 46528.

Offers shall be filed with the City of Goshen Clerk-Treasurer's Office, 202 South Fifth Street, Goshen, Indiana 46528 on or before 1:45 p.m. (local time), Monday April 29, 2019. Bids arriving after the specified time may not be accepted. The City of Goshen is not responsible for late or lost bids due to mail service inadequacies, traffic or other similar reasons. No facsimiles or emails of bids will be accepted.

The bids received will be taken to the Board of Public Works and Safety meeting to be publicly opened and read aloud. The Board meeting will be held in City Court Room/Council Chambers at the Goshen Police & Court Building, 111 East Jefferson Street, Goshen. The reading of the proposals, however, does not determine the award of the bid. All proposals submitted become the property of the City and are a matter of public record.

The City of Goshen reserves the right to reject any and all offers, to withdraw an item from sale at any time and when in the best interest of the City, to waive any informalities or irregularities in any bid received, and to award a bid, consistent with Indiana law, to the highest responsible bidder.
