

City of Goshen's Sidewalk 50/50 Program
Procedure for getting your sidewalk installed/repaired

1. Fill out both sides of the Sidewalk Application/Estimate
(You do not need to fill out the table with square footage or figure out the cost) If your address is different than the address in which the sidewalk is to be done (i.e. rental) be sure to write that in the line that says "Address of property where work is to be completed." Also, write any comments you have for the contractor (i.e. "I want sidewalk only", or "only the cracked portion" (attach drawing).)
2. Turn in the Application to the City's Engineering Department.
(The deadline for Applications to be turned in is September 9, 2016)
3. The Engineering Department will forward your application to the contractor hired to do the sidewalk work.
4. The contractor will go to your requested address and measure the square footage of the sidewalk and/or curb. He will fill out the table on your application, and figure out the cost to do your sidewalk.
5. The contractor will then mail you a copy of the application.
The price on the application is the whole cost. You would only be responsible for 50% of that cost.
6. If you don't want to proceed and not get your sidewalk done, you simply do nothing. We do not need to be notified.
7. If you would like to proceed, you will need to come into the Engineering office at 204 E. Jefferson Street and fill out an Agreement. Your 50% of the cost will be due at the signing of the Agreement. All property owners must sign the Agreement.
8. The City will notify the contractor that you have signed an Agreement, and the contractor will begin work as soon as their schedule allows. (The deadline for Agreements is September 30, 2016). Residents are responsible for lawn repair after installation.
