Nichols/Landis moved to approve the agenda as amended. Passed 2-0

Nichols/Landis moved to approve the minutes as presented. Passed 2-0

Open Bids for Single-axle Dump Truck

Landis opened the sealed bids.

Selking International - \$178,136.41

Truck Centers Inc. - \$176,328.00

Landis/Nichols moved to refer these bids to the Legal Department. Passed 2-0

Request for Awning Extending into Right-of-way: 108 North Main Street

Randy Harvell with Awnings Unlimited presented his request.

Planning and Zoning Assistant Administrator Rossa Deegan stated the Planning Department has no issue with this request.

Nichols/Landis moved to approve the awning at 108 North Main Street. Passed 2-0



Request for Sewer Charge Relief: 1120 South Main Street

Dylan Abshire presented his request.

Abshire stated that he made first contact with the Utilities Office and was able to identify the leak. Added that no water was found outside or inside the residence.

Water and Sewer Superintendent Kent Holdren stated that no evidence has been found as to where the water went.

Utility Billing Clerk Michelle Eldridge provided documentation as to when and how Abshire was contacted.

Nichols/Landis moved to table the Request for Sewer Charge Relief until the April 26, 2021 Board of Public Works meeting. Passed 2-0

College Avenue Lane Restrictions near Lincolnway East/U.S. 33, JN: 2016-0021

Director of Public Works Dustin Sailor presented the packet memo.

Nichols/Landis moved to approve the lane restrictions along College Avenue near the intersection with Lincolnway East/U.S. 33 from April 5 until August 27, 2021. Passed 2-0

Dierdorff Road Closure North of College Avenue, JN: 2016-0021

Sailor presented the packet memo.

Nichols/Landis moved to approve the closure of Dierdorff Road between U.S. 33 and College Avenue from April 6 until August 27, 2021. Passed 2-0

North Main Street Partial Lane Restrictions, JN: 2016-0020

Sailor presented the packet memo.

Nichols/Landis moved to approve the North Main Street partial lane restriction between Rock Run Creek Bridge and Pike Street on April 6, 2021. Passed 2-0

Olive Street Closure at Lincoln Avenue, JN: 2019-0046

Sailor presented the packet memo.

Nichols/Landis moved to approve the adjusted dates of the closure of Olive Street, just north of Lincoln Avenue, from April 6 until April 8, 2021. Passed 2-0



West Washington Street 2-hour, Customer/Visitor Parking Signs

Nichols/Landis moved to approve the Traffic Commission recommendation to replace the current 2-hour parking signs along West Washington Street with "Customer and Visitor Parking Only" signs. Passed 2-0
