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
6. Traffic Control





- The pavement on Eisenhower Drive N. & S. have not been reconstructed in over 20 years. With the constant truck traffic, the pavement bed has deteriorated and the pavement cross-section has reached the end of its service life.
 - In recent years, the road has been chip & sealed a couple times to extend the pavement's life.
- Phase 1 Reconstruct the private railroad spur crossing
- Phase 2 Full depth pavement removal of the <u>outside</u> lane on Eisenhower Drive N. & S.
- Phase 3 Full depth pavement removal of the <u>inside</u> lane on Eisenhower Drive N. & S.






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Concerns

- Project is funded by the Goshen Redevelopment Commission
 - The Commission meets the second Tuesday of the month at 3 p.m. in the court room at 111 E. Jefferson St.
- Money for the project is generated from new development within the defined Tax Increment Finance District



Project cost as bid: \$1,787,372.45



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Concerns

- May 3 Construction notice signs to be placed
- May 12 26 Traffic control setup & railroad track reconstruction
- May 27 June 28 Traffic control setup & reconstruction of outside travel lane
- June 29 July 30 Traffic control setup & reconstruction of inside travel lane
- Aug. 4 Pavement markings
- Aug. 9 Completion



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- Road closure at tracks for railroad track reconstruction
 - North & South Eisenhower Drive traffic will be divided
- Reconstruction of outside travel lane
 - Traffic will enter Eisenhower Drive S. and leave through Eisenhower Drive N.
- Reconstruction of inside travel lane
 - Traffic will enter Eisenhower Drive S. and leave through Eisenhower Drive N.
 - This will be strange for driver to drive on the wrong side of the road; therefore, this is the second part of the traffic control

Under traffic pavement marking installation



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- What to expect
 - Areas where pavement is removed will be built-up with temporary millings
 - Employees should plan on delays getting in and out of work at peak times – *Encourage them to plan* ahead
 - Employers may want to consider staggered start and end schedules during construction
 - Transporters will not be able to stage on or along the road
 - Mailbox locations will be switched temporarily to accommodate traffic pattern changes
 - Contractor will start at 9 am to avoid adding to the morning traffic
 - Contractor will work later (i.e., 8 pm)
