- Collects samples.
- Conducts analysis of EPA requirements to ensure quality control.
- Prepares samples for analysis.
- Maintains sampling equipment as needed.
- Order laboratory supplies and equipment as needed.
- Performs other related essential duties as required.

Minimum Training and Experience Required:

High school diploma or equivalent combination of education, training, and experience.

Special Requirements:

- Class I Wastewater Certification or Class A industrial certification preferred.
- Vocational/technical training or laboratory experience.
